

**Ricky Timms Convergence Technique Wall Hanging
PAULA'S VERSION for completed 25 inch square
topper/ wall hanging.**

Material list:

- **four 18 inch squares -in coordinating
Colors. (I used dark purple, dark blue,
Light purple, light blue.)**
- **2 ½ inch strips for border and binding**
- **27 inch square material for backing**
- **27 inch square batting**
- **Sewing machine in good working order and all
sewing supplies**
- **A large cutting matt, rotary cutter, and long
ruler. NOTE: It is easier if you have a cutting
and laying out space close to your machine.**

**This will make a completed 25 inch table
topper. However if you want to make a long
rectangular table runner you would need to
repeat process two more times. For a jacket you
would repeat process three more times and use
your favorite jacket pattern. Once you learn the
process you can let your imagination go wild- I
have seen sea, forest, barns, landscapes, florals,
etc. for an interesting take on using this
technique.**
