## Fabric Yardage

<i>S</i>	<i>R</i>	<i>Bk</i>	
<i>Star</i>	<i>Ribbon</i>	<i>Background</i>	<i>Backing</i>
½ yd	1 yd	¾ yd	1 yd

This does not have to be Christmas colors any 3 colors will work fine. Please try to select fabrics that contrast well.

Additional supplies include Batting 30" X 32" Batting – High loft is best, or use regular batting with a wool batting on top

Recommended tool: 10" Clearview Triangle (60°) Any ruler with 30° and 60° angle lines will work.

PREWORK: Cut strips width-of-fabric (WOF) as follows:

Star fabric	1 strip 3 ½ inch wide	2 strips 3" wide
Ribbon fabric	1 strip 3 ½ inch wide	1 strip 3" wide
Background fabric	1 strip 3 ½ inch wide	5 strips 3" wide

From these strips subcut the following:

**Using Star fabric**

1 strip 3 ½ inch wide	Cut in half (½ WOF) 3½ inch wide	Cut 1 of the ½ WOF in half to make 2 ¼ WOF still 3½ inch wide
2 strips 3 inch wide	Cut in 1 strip in half (½ WOF) 3 inch wide	Cut the <u>other</u> 3" strip in half and half again making 4 ¼ WOF strips

**Using Ribbon fabric**

1 strip 3 ½ inch wide	Cut in half (½ WOF) 3½ inch wide	Cut 1 of the ½ WOF in half to make 2 ¼ WOF still 3½ inch wide
1 strip 3 inch wide	Cut in 1 strip in half (½ WOF) 3 inch wide, then cut in half again making 4 ¼ WOF strips each 3" wide.	

**Using Background fabric**

1 strip 3 ½ inch wide	Cut in half (½ WOF) 3½ inch wide	Cut 1 of the ½ WOF in half to make 2 ¼ WOF still 3½ inch wide
2 strips 3 inch wide	Cut 2 strips in half (½ WOF) 3 inch wide	Cut the 1 of the ½ WOF 3" strip in half again making 2 ¼ WOF strips

For large bow you will need 2 additional strips of ribbon fabric 7" X 30" each. This can be done later.
