

Patchwork Basket Supply List (medium basket sizes in parentheses)

Directions will be given for two sizes - please choose one to make in this class.

Small basket is approx. 3 1/2 x 6" x 4" high

Medium basket is approx. 5" x 7" x 4 1/2" high

Two 15" (20") strips each of two coordinating fabrics, cut 2" wide  
(4 total strips, two of each color)

One 12" strip of lining fabric or one of the two patchwork fabrics (for lining handles),  
cut 2" wide

Lining - 12" x 12" (16" x 16") piece of fabric (or just grab a fat quarter)

1/4 yd. cotton canvas/duck - This will be a lot more than necessary for one basket, so  
you may want to share with a friend or plan on making several baskets.

**Don't launder this fabric.**

Note: The original pattern called for linen; but I didn't want to ask everyone to pay a  
premium price for this class. If you happen to have a piece of linen on hand,  
and would like to use it, please feel free to do so.

Interfacing - Fusible fleece gives more body than regular fleece. I always thought a tiny bit  
heavier in these baskets would be nice, so I experimented with Pellon FF78F1;  
however, I did not like it at all for this application, especially after breaking a needle!  
I'm pretty clueless about the many interfacings out there today, so, if you have a  
favorite that will give soft body, but not stiffness, please use whatever you prefer.  
12" x 12" (16" x 16") piece needed.

Sewing machine and the usual basics - Bisk, cutting surface, ruler, rotary cutter, iron/ironing  
surface. Include thread to match color of canvas/duck, along with thread to blend  
with other fabrics. You will also need a ballpoint pen.
