## Tiny Stars Wall Hanging

This is a paper pieced project. Blocks are about 2" which are put together to form a star shape. The final piece will be about 18 inch square. It is easy enough even if you are new to paper piecing.

For this you will need the following pieces

- Variety of colors in following sizes. Batiks work very well but any kind of fabric will work. This is the time to get out that tub of scraps you can't bear to throw away. Pieces should be at least the following sizes but if they are a bit more please don't sit and trim.

72- 3.5" x 1"

72 -3" x 1"

72- 2.5 x 1.5

It won't matter if you have a lot of the same fabric, we will put the pieces in a big pile and you can swap some of yours with fellow class members.

- Also need 36 pieces of black 2" x 4" or any other dark fabric. You want *GOOD* contrast with the other fabrics. This will make the star shape stand out.
- Border fabric and binding-3 strips WOF of your favorite width for border and 3 strips WOF for binding. If using same fabric for both, 5 strips will easily do both unless you make wide borders. Your center piece will be about 12 inches square.
- Backing and batting for about 18 - 20 inches square
- Other needs:
  - Sewing machine in working order
  - Usual sewing supplies
  - Rotary cutter with small mat
  - Add-a-quarter ruler or small 6" ruler or 4" X 8" or 6" square ruler with quarter inch markings
- It would be helpful if several people have small iron and ironing mat to share between table mates.

You will be working on a special foundation material. I the patterns printed on the sheets available for the project at cost.
