

Knitted Round Dish Cloth

Sugar and Cream Yarn – One skein makes two cloths size 8 needles

Cast on 15 stitches

Row 1: K3, YO, K11 1 stitch left, turn

Row2 and all even rows Knit, turn

Row.3: K3, YO, K11 2 stitches left, turn

Row5: K3, YO, K11 3 stitches left, turn

Row7: Bind off 3 k2 , YO, K8, 4 stitches left, turn (First scallop made)

Row9: K3, YO, K8, 5 stitches left, turn

Row11: K3, YO, K8, 6 stitches left, turn

Row 13: Bind off 3 stitches, K2, YO,K5, 7 stitches left, turn (Second scallop made)

Row 15: K3, YO, K5,8 stitches left, turn

Row 17: K3,YO,K5, 9 stitches left, turn

Row 19: Bind off 3 stitches, knit to end (third scallop made)

Row 20 Knit across

Repeat rows 1-20 7 or 8 times.

Bind off and leave end to sew seam. Be sure to pull center circle tight.

Check count as you go along, It's easy to make a mistake.

☞ If made with yarn similar to Aunt Lydia's Rug Yarn and Size 10 needles makes a good pad for hot dishes on the table.
